With the 10 ECTS-course PRO 509 Consulting and Research Project both undergraduate and graduate students can choose to begin the trimester in online format two weeks prior to the official trimester start in Oct. in order to complete the full 30 ECTS.

Application Procedure	 Nomination by home institution/university to international-office@accadis.com On confirmation of your nomination, you will be receiving the application form by email Documents required: Official Transcript of Records in English Copy of passport/national ID card 1 photo (digital)
Transcript of Records (ToR)	An official ToR will be issued by accadis no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished. Students are responsible for downloading their grades themselves from the accadis Portal.
Accommodation	You will be receiving detailed information in form of the accadis Housing Booklet, once you are enrolled and have informed us of your housing preference. accadis Hochschule does not have student residences of its own but many contacts for private student residences, landlords and students wishing to sublet their accommodation during their semester abroad. accadis Academic Affairs will support exchange students with information on accommodation, but students will need to search on their own. The housing market in the Rhein-Main area is a tight one and will require effort from the applicants in securing inexpensive accommodation. A Housing Request Form will be sent to you together with the application form so that we are informed of your preferences.

Transportation	Bad Homburg-Ober-Eschbach lies in close vicinity to Frankfurt/Main. Very good access by public transport by bus or U2 tram – stops just minutes away. Right off the motorway. Limited free parking close by.
Visa	None for EU-students. A visa is required for most non-EU students and in some cases also a residence permit. Guidance in the Intl. Student Handbook*
Health Insurance	accadis guides incoming and outgoing students in obtaining insurance coverage. Incoming students are responsible for making sure that they have appropriate insurance coverage during the exchange period. All students are required to have health insurance. EU-students are usually covered by the health insurance of their home country. Students living outside the EU must purchase mandatory health insurance and provide accadis with evidence thereof *
Special Needs	accadis as much as possible takes into consideration the special needs of incoming students and staff. Most of our facilities are wheelchair accessible. Special exam arrangements can be made for those with a diagnosed special need. Incoming students and staff members with special needs are advised to inform the accadis Academic Affairs about their needs before arrival. Any information concerning the health of students and staff is kept confidential in strict adherence to GDPR.

accadis Buddy/ Student Orientation	accadis will put you in contact with a personal accadis Buddy in advance of our program. This student will help you with any non-academic questions or challenges which you may be facing. accadis also organizes an orientation session for exchange students at the beginning of every trimester. In October there is always a dedicated orientation week opening the new academic year. For the spring and summer trimesters, orientation is usually held a few days before the beginning of classes. accadis Academic Affairs will inform you of the timing in due time.
Arrival Services – Pick-up	We will gladly arrange to have you picked up at the airport or train station and brought to your accommodation if you inform us at least 2 weeks ahead of time. Your Study Buddies will also be happy to help out.
